A BILL

To protect American job creation by striking the job-killing Federal employer mandate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Job Protec-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECT JOB CREATION.**

7 Sections 1513 and 1514 and subsections (e), (f), and
8 (g) of section 10106 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
9 able Care Act (and the amendments made by such sections
10 and subsections) are repealed and the Internal Revenue

- 1 Code of 1986 shall be applied and administered as if such
- 2 provisions and amendments had never been enacted.
