The American Benefits Council will host a **Benefits Briefing webinar** on **Friday, July 26**, at **2 p.m. Eastern Time**, for further discussion of the recent U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) <u>Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPRM)</u> establishing new rules for defined contribution retirement plans, in connection with the DOL's regulatory project addressing the individual "pension benefit statements" required under the Pension Protection Act (PPA) of 2006. <u>DOL recently extended the deadline for comments</u> on the ANPRM to August 7, 2013.

This second session will focus on the "lifetime income illustration" requirement proposed by the ANPRM. *Jeff Turner*, Deputy Director, Office of Regulations and Interpretations at DOL's Employee Benefits Security Administration, will be on hand to discuss the rule and answer questions. ## **Background:**

The ANPRM explores whether and how the individual benefit statement must present a participant's accrued benefits in a defined contribution plan as a lifetime income stream of payments as well as in the form of an individual account balance. Along with the ANPRM, DOL and EBSA have made available on its website a <u>fact sheet</u> and <u>an interactive calculator</u> that calculates lifetime income streams in accordance with the suggested regulatory framework.

**Lynn Dudley**, senior vice president, retirement and international policy, will moderate the call. As noted above, she will be joined by **Jeff Turner**, Deputy Director, Office of Regulations and Interpretations at DOL's Employee Benefits Security Administration. **Kent Mason** from Davis & Harman LLP, will also provide additional analysis.
