IEBA (<http://www.ieba.org.uk/>) is an educational and professional development network for benefits practitioners throughout Europe. Established over 20 years ago, IEBA is headquartered in the United Kingdom with branches there and in Belgium, France, Germany, Netherlands, the Nordic countries, Switzerland, and the United States. (The Council serves as the U.S. branch of IEBA.) In addition to sponsoring regular programs featuring on-line materials accessible to all members, IEBA holds an annual meeting in Brussels, headquarters of the European Union.

IEBA also awards the highly-regarded Diploma in International Employee Benefits (Dip. IEB) to those successfully completing the required examinations as administered by the U.K.-based Pension Management Institute. Educational materials are available to both those undertaking the Diploma exams and to benefits professionals who simply wish to review comprehensive information on international employee benefits matters.
